

3 **Resolution Regarding the Standard Administrative**
4 **Policies and Procedures; *Conflict of Interest***

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6 **WHEREAS**, the new Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures (SAPP), Conflict of Interest, was
7 introduced by the Office of General Counsel; and

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9 **WHEREAS**, the proposed SAPP, Conflict of Interest, is to help regulate conflicts of commitment and
10 interest especially in research and working with foreign entities; and

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12 **WHEREAS**, the Chair of the Faculty Senate requested that the Faculty Senate Executive Committee and
13 the Faculty Academic Standards, Rights & Responsibilities Committee review the proposed SAPP; and

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15 **WHEREAS**, the Faculty Academic Standards, Rights & Responsibilities Committee prepared a report
16 stating that they did not feel the document was ready to be presented; and

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18 **WHEREAS**, concerns were presented to the Conflict of Interest working group which provided a revised
19 document; and

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21 **WHEREAS**, changes to Standard Administrative Polices and Procedures have important implications to
22 the University Faculty and to the welfare of the University;

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24 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Faculty Senate of the University of Wyoming that Faculty
25 Senate supports the Conflict of Interest SAPP as proposed by the Conflict of Interest working group, with
26 the adoption of the tracked change amendments approved by the Faculty Senate as shown on the attached
27 version.
