## Resolution in Support of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention Policy SAP

**WHEREAS**, at the September 2016 Board of Trustees meeting, the Board approved review by UW Administration of UW's current regulatory structure, to include the following:

- 1) Phasing out presidential directives;
- 2) Defining regulation versus policy/procedure;
- 3) Creating an online manual, including a new "look" and format for the regulations; and
- 4) Updating the substance of the regulations, policies, and procedures as needed, including determining whether there are any substantive gaps; and

**WHEREAS**, the new structure will involve three levels of review:

- 1) Governing regulations (Level A)
- 2) Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level B), and
- 3) Department/Unit Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level C); and

**WHEREAS,** per the University's Policies and Procedures Vetting Process any new or modified policy or procedure is sent to a Policy Review Group that includes the Chair of the Faculty Senate; and

WHEREAS, in 2018, the University sunset its Alcohol and Other Drugs Policy; and

*WHEREAS,* General Counsel has worked with UWPD, Human Resources, Student Affairs, Finance, and the AWARE and A-Teams to redraft and revise that policy to the University's Standard Administrative Policy and Procedure (SAP) format and to comply with Section 22 of the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of 1989; and

**WHEREAS,** the Faculty Senate Chair, in consultation with the Faculty Senate Executive Committee presents this proposed SAP to the Faculty Senate for review and consideration;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Faculty Senate of the University of Wyoming that Faculty Senate supports the adoption of the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention Policy SAP.
