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8 **WHEREAS**, at the September 2016 Board of Trustees meeting, the Board approved review by UW
9 Administration of UW’s current regulatory structure, to include the following:

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11 1) Phasing out presidential directives;
12 2) Defining regulation versus policy/procedure;
13 3) Creating an online manual, including a new “look” and format for the regulations; and
14 4) Updating the substance of the regulations, policies, and procedures as needed, including
15 determining whether there are any substantive gaps; and
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17 **WHEREAS**, the new structure will involve three levels of policies:

- 18 1) Governing Regulations (Level A),
19 2) Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level B), and
20 3) Department/Unit Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level C); and
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22 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees approved a new UW Regulation 2-13, *Academic Program*
23 *Reorganization, Consolidation, Reduction and Discontinuance*, in July 2018 that will go into effect July 1,
24 2019; and
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26 **WHEREAS**, the new UW Regulation 2-13 requires a Standard Administrative Policy & Procedure (SAPP)
27 to define policies and procedures in implementing UW Regulation 2-13; and
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29 **WHEREAS**, the new UW Regulation 1-101, *UW Regulations and Standard Administrative Policies and*
30 *Procedures*, approved by the Board of Trustees in July 2018 and effective July 1, 2019, states that “As
31 part of the review [of SAPPs], the President shall seek input from the Faculty Senate.”; and
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33 **WHEREAS**, the Faculty Senate Faculty Academic Standards, Rights and Responsibilities Committee
34 reviewed the proposed SAPP and worked with Academic Affairs and faculty constituents to develop
35 recommended amendments to the proposed SAPP; therefore
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37 **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Faculty Senate:

38 Supports the General Counsel’s and Academic Affairs’s proposed SAPP for UW Regulation 2-13
39 with the recommended tracked-change amendments included in the attached copy of the proposed UW
40 Regulation 2-13 Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures.
