6 **Resolution in Support of General Counsel Proposed Revisions to**
7 **UW Regulation 6-400, *Academic Class Management*;**
8 **and the Elimination of UW Regulations 6-403, *Class Meetings Outside Scheduled***
9 ***Times*; 6-405 *Final Examinations*; and 6-721, *Class Numbering Structure***

11 **WHEREAS**, at the September 2016 Board of Trustees meeting, the Board approved review by UW
12 Administration of UW’s current regulatory structure, to include the following:

- 13 1) Phasing out presidential directives;
14 2) Defining regulation versus policy/procedure;
15 3) Creating an online manual, including a new “look” and format for the regulations; and
16 4) Updating the substance of the regulations, policies, and procedures as needed, including
17 determining whether there are any substantive gaps; and
18

19 **WHEREAS**, the new structure will involve three levels of policies:

- 20 1) Governing Regulations (Level A),
21 2) Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level B), and
22 3) Department/Unit Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level C); and
23

24 **WHEREAS**, the University’s Routing Process for new or revised UW Regulations includes review by
25 the Chair of the Faculty Senate; and
26

27 **WHEREAS**, the Chair of the Faculty Senate has requested that the Faculty Senate Executive
28 Committee review, and the Faculty Senate approve, some modifications to the regulations proposed by
29 General Counsel; and
30

31 **WHEREAS**, the changes to the Regulations covered by this Resolution have important implications to
32 the University Faculty and to the welfare of the University;
33

34 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Faculty Senate of the University of Wyoming that the Faculty
35 Senate supports the modifications of UW Regulation 6-400, *Academic Class Management*, which
36 incorporates sunsetted UW Regulations 6-403, 6-405, and 6-721 as referred to in the title above; and

38 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the Faculty Senate of the University of Wyoming that the Faculty
39 Senate supports the modifications to UW Regulation 6-400, *Academic Class Management*, as proposed by
40 General Counsel, with the adoption of the tracked-change amendments approved by the Faculty Senate as
41 shown on the attached versions.
