2 **Resolution in Support of General Counsel’s and Academic Affairs’s**
3 **Proposed UW Regulation 2-7 Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures:**
4 ***Procedures for Implementing and Evaluating Rolling Contracts***

7 **WHEREAS**, at the September 2016 Board of Trustees meeting, the Board approved review by UW
8 Administration of UW’s current regulatory structure, to include the following:
9

- 10 1) Phasing out presidential directives;
11 2) Defining regulation versus policy/procedure;
12 3) Creating an online manual, including a new “look” and format for the regulations; and
13 4) Updating the substance of the regulations, policies, and procedures as needed, including
14 determining whether there are any substantive gaps; and
15

16 **WHEREAS**, the new structure will involve three levels of policies:

- 17 1) Governing Regulations (Level A),
18 2) Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level B), and
19 3) Department/Unit Administrative Policies and Procedures (Level C); and
20

21 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees approved a new UW Regulation 2-7, *Procedures for Reappointment,*
22 *Tenure, Promotion and Fixed-Term*, in July 2018 that will go into effect July 1, 2019; and
23

24 **WHEREAS**, the new UW Regulation 2-7 requires a Standard Administrative Policy & Procedure (SAPP) to
25 define policies and procedures in implementing UW Regulation 2-7; and

27 **WHEREAS**, the new UW Regulation 1-101, *UW Regulations and Standard Administrative Policies and*
28 *Procedures*, approved by the Board of Trustees in July 2018 and effective July 1, 2019, states that “As
29 part of the review [of SAPPs], the President shall seek input from the Faculty Senate..”; and
30

31 **WHEREAS**, the Faculty Senate Faculty Academic Standards, Rights and Responsibilities Committee
32 reviewed the proposed SAPP and worked with Academic Affairs and faculty constituents to develop
33 recommended amendments to the proposed SAPP; therefore
34

35 **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Faculty Senate:

36 Supports the General Counsel’s and Academic Affairs’s proposed SAPP for UW Regulation 2-7
37 with the recommended tracked-change amendments included in the attached copy of the proposed UW
38 Regulation 2-7 Standard Administrative Policies and Procedures.
