The University Reappointment, Tenure and Promotion Committee deliberated eleven reappointment, tenure and promotion cases and submitted its recommendations to the Provost. In the process, and as directed by UW Reg. 2-7(XII), the Committee considered whether the standards of UW Reg. 2-7(III) “are being consistently applied campus-wide by examining the procedures and general eligibility qualifications of candidates.” The Committee did not report any inconsistencies to any college committee or dean, but will likely make policy recommendations to the Provost in accordance with UW Reg. 2-7(XII).
