UW and CSU require 120 minimum credits to graduate. In earning a bachelor's degree from both universities and meet all the requirements for teacher licensure, students will be exceptionally well prepared to meet today's FACS students' needs. If UW students want to enroll in more credits some semesters and if courses are available or take some summer courses, they might be able to reduce the UW or CSU semesters. A minimum 30 unique CSU credits are required for a second degree.
