

# Semester Tuition and Fee Schedule 2009 – 2010

The University of Wyoming semester fee schedules are shown below. The University Trustees and the university administration reserve the right to change the amounts for tuition and fees at any time.

Undergraduate students enrolled for 12 or more hours are considered to be attending full-time. At the graduate level, 9 hours is considered full-time and less than 9 hours is classified as part-time. Fees do not include special fees.
