Join UW in Jerusalem to build your research capacity, establish international connections, think across disciplines, and make opportunities for our students and state in the Middle East.

UW in Jerusalem is a Signature Program within the Center for Global Studies. It will convene UW faculty from across the disciplines, bring them into conversation around the challenges, resources and opportunities of a unique place; support a community of approximately twelve faculty for transdisciplinary exploration in Jerusalem; feature those faculty as field experts in conversation with their UW colleagues and colleagues in Israel/Palestine; facilitate relationship-building with colleagues and institutions in the region; establish the foundation for future Jerusalem-based research and teaching led by UW faculty.

Successful applicants will:

- Participate in a bi-weekly preparatory colloquium, Fall 2021 including information-sharing and relationship building
- o Participate in a week-long on-site colloquium based in Jerusalem, 2-9 January 2022

including: sites (ancient and recent),

challenges (environmental, historical)

cultures

landscapes ... (activities will support the range of participants)

example: study at Caesarea will engage Roman architecture and the cityscape; trade routes by land and sea; shoreline biology; tourist and neighboring industrial economies; competing narratives of place...

- o Be prepared to co-lead such a course for UW students in the future
- o Actively develop their research and engagement network in Israel/Palestine
