





Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship Program

Open to undergraduate students receiving Federal Pell Grant funding at a two-year or four-year college or university to participate in study and intern abroad programs worldwide. https://www.iie.org/Programs/Gilman-Scholarship-Program

Critical Language Scholarship (CLS) Program

Is an intensive overseas language and cultural immersion program for American students enrolled at U.S. colleges and universities. The program includes intensive instruction and structured cultural enrichment experiences designed to promote rapid language gains. Critical Languages Offered: Azerbaijani, Bangla, Hindi, Indonesian, Korean, Punjabi, Swahili, Turkish, and Urdu (Beginner-Advanced); Arabic and Persian (Advanced Beginner-Advanced); and Chinese, Japanese, and Russian (Intermediate- Advanced). CLS is a program of the United States Department of State's Bureau of Educational & Cultural Affairs. Boren Awards

Boren Scholarships, provide unique funding opportunities for U.S. undergraduate students to study less commonly taught lanaguages in world regions critical to U.S. interests, and underrepresented in study abroad, including Africa, Asia, Central and Eastern Europe, Eurasia, Latin America, and the Middle East. The countries of Western Europe, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand are excluded. Boren Scholars represent a vital pool of highly motivated individuals who wish to work in the federal national security arena.
