Innovation Center

HR has been working closely with Academic Affairs and select users of HCM Recruiting to review and streamline recruitment related business processes. The committee was able to provide the following business process improvements, which resulted in a more efficient process for Temporary Lecturer hires. The group was able to address the following:

- Elimination of workflow approvals, where appropriate
- Direct hire email collected in Requisition, resulting in ability for recruiter to reach out directly
- Condensed candidate application process
- Refined offer process, including a streamlined offer extension and acceptance process

Ultimately, data ran prior to the changes and after the changes resulted in a more efficient and timely process.

Under the new process, average time to hire went from an average of 24 days to 6.5 days. HR is hoping to continue their work with Academic Affairs and campus users to review and streamline other recruitment processes as well.
