Wyoming Endorsement in Adapted Physical Education

In addition to being state certified in physical education teacher education K-12, and having completed at least one course in adapted physical education, an individual must complete the following courses (or equivalent courses from another university/college) to be endorsed in adapted physical education K-12 in Wyoming:

Individuals who graduate with a Bachelors Degree in Physical Education Teacher Education from the University of Wyoming will have successfully completed KIN 4055, Adapted Physical Education. University of Wyoming graduates in Physical Education Teacher Education must complete the three courses identified above for an endorsement in adapted physical education.
