K&HP UPPER-DIVISION PROGRAM CRITERIA

To be eligible to enroll in upper division coursework as part of the Kinesiology and Health Promotion (K&HP) program and to enter the program gateway course (KIN 3021 & 3022), the coursework listed on this page needs to be completed with a minimum 2.75 GPA¹ (preferred 3.00). With the guidance of your advisor, you will determine whether you have completed the appropriate coursework, in order to move on to the upper-division coursework in your final two years of the K&HP program.

<u>Please note</u>: In addition to the minimum GPA¹ requirement of 2.75, enrollment in KIN 3021 (Physiology of Exercise) requires a grade of C or better in Math, Anatomy, and Human Systems Physiology courses. Students who receive grades lower than a C in these courses will not be allowed to enroll in KIN 3021.

¹ GPA may be UW, transfer, or combination. UW GPA is the default, but in borderline cases, the Division Director orProfessional Advisor may use the transfer GPA or grades earned in key courses from transfer institutions.

NOTE: Student Criminal Background Check <u>must</u> be completed the semester *prior to* enrollment in KIN/HLED 4015 or 4016. This is a College of Health Sciences requirement.

CPR Certification requirement

You must be CPR certified prior to starting your internship/research experience. You will need to provide documentation when you apply for your internship/research experience the semester before you plan to complete it. You can complete the CPR requirement in any number of ways, including through a community college course, through the American Red Cross, American Heart Association, through UW HalfAcre, or through any other organization near you.

Internship or Research Experience (6-12 credit hours)

Students must complete an internship experience (KIN/HLED 4015) or research experience (KIN/HLED 4016) as part of the Kinesiology and Health Promotion major. The internship/research experience must be at least 6 credit hours, but no more than 12 credit hours. One credit hour of internship/research experience is equivalent to 40 contact hours. Your internship/research experience can be completed during the fall, spring, or summer. The selection of a site and arrangements for the internship/research experience should be discussed with your advisor and the internship/research coordinator once you have completed KIN 3021/3022 and KIN 3010. Please note that only 6 credits of KIN 4016 are allowed towards graduation.
