The goal of the legal resume is to get an interview.

It's your one chance to make a great first impression.

- ⇒ Emphasize how your requirements meet those of the position by describing the parts of your education, work and life experiences that are most pertinent to the job. Be sure your resume is practice focused!
- ⇒ Follow the specific legal format that allows reviewers to see the most important information easily within a 30-60 scan through the document.
- ⇒ Include appropriate personal interests, community involvement or other relevant experiences that will convey a sense of who you are as an individual and as a potential employee.
