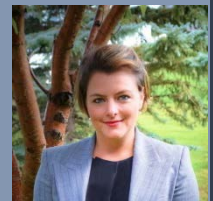


A panel of three distinguished individuals will provide their perspectives and experiences regarding the fluctuation and uncertainty in the energy industry, including its impact on the legal community.

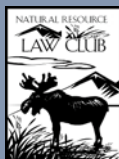
