2.45.1. Emperors Diocletian and Maximian and the Caesars to Eutychianus.

If a partition is made between minors under twenty-five years of age either with or without writing and without any fraud, and they ratify it after they become of age, it should remain undisturbed.

2.45.2. The same emperors and Caesars to Soterus.

Persons who, after the twenty-fifth year of their age, ratify acts which they did during minority, uselessly ask recession thereof.
