Concerning the infamous. (De infamibus.)

10.59.1. Emperors Diocletian and Maximian to Charito.

Although infamous persons can enjoy no honors which are accustomed to be bestowed on those who bear a good name, they are not exempt from curial or municipal liturgies. They must also pay the customary levies for public protection.

Note.

A distinction is here drawn between "curialia munera" and "civilia munera." The latter here doubtless referred to positions of the lower grades, the former referring, probably, to the municipal honors and those positions which were said to "cohere" to positions of honor. See headnote C. 10.42. A principle similar to that stated in the instant law is also stated in C. 10.32.12 and C. 12.35.3.
