Since the property of your mother is said to be exhausted by gifts of dowry, it is clear that it is consonant with the laws that, in pattern of actions for setting testaments aside as unjust, opportunity should be afforded to bring an action against immoderate gifts of dowry, and that the amount owing to the complaining sons, should be paid.
