That a guardian shall assist in a suit after the age of puberty of the minor. (Ut causae post pubertatem adsit tutor.)

5.48.1. Emperor Philip to Dextrus.

It has often been stated in rescripts that guardians who have not yet transferred their management (of the minor's property) to curators, must assist in defending lawsuits of their former minor wards. 1. And if, therefore, as you say, the persons (such guardians) whom you mentioned detain documents which can support the reason for an appeal, the president of the province will, when called upon, direct that they be admonished of their danger.¹
