## Concerning an excuse of veterans. (De excusatione veteranorum.)

Bas. 38.1.81 and 82.

## 5.65.1. Emperor Antoninus to Saturninus.

Those who are honorably discharged from military service after 20 years retain their good name and have a claim on the public privileges granted to veterans. Promulgated August 7 (213).

## 5.65.2. Emperor Gordian to Celeres, a Veteran.

As to the rule that veterans are compelled to undertake the management of a guardianship or curatorship only of the sons of comrades or soldiers and that only one at the same time, [this] implies that if they are appointed to others they may, within the customary times offer their reasons for the excuse to a competent judge. Promulgated June 29 (239).
