11.27.1. Emperors Valentinian and Valens to Symmachus, City Prefect. Anyone, shown to have a ship on the Tiber, must perform public (transportation) duty. All ships, therefore, found on the Tiber are bound to perform the proper and customary services, and no rank or privilege shall give exemption therefrom.
