You should not be unaware that a minor's cause may be defended by one guardian or curator when the others refuse to do so. Promulgated November 5 (214).

5.40.2. Emperor Constantine and Caesar Licinius to Symnachus.

If the administration of a guardianship or curatorship in any province is separate from that in another, only the guardians or curators may sue or be sued in a particular province who officiate therein (as such), lest defenders of minors be summoned to court from other provinces.¹
