[Novel 143 is one of two pair of “doublets” in the “Greek Collection of 168.” That is, novel 143 is the same as novel 150. The “Greek Collection of 168” was the basis for Schoell and Kroll’s authoritative Latin translation, which, in turn, Blume used for this English translation.
