Civil issues including special education, mediation, debt collection, fair housing, guardianship, emancipation, expungements, landlord/tenant, & veteran disability for low-income clients  
Divorce, child custody, domestic violence, adoption, juvenile, & select immigration cases for low-income clients

Innocence claims made by Wyoming state prisoners, direct appeals & other post-conviction relief, & local trial work

Simple wills, power of attorney, & living wills for low-income clients

Clients looking to start a small business in Wyoming or move their business to Wyoming

Variety of civil issues including family, abuse, housing, money, end of life planning, employment, public benefits, health care, expungements, and power of attorney for primarily low-income clients

Hosts volunteer reference attorney events & free legal advice clinics

Virtual legal advice clinic for civil legal questions answered by state attorney volunteers authorized to provide free legal assistance

Holistic services providing direct legal assistance and support for children or their families in crisis in juvenile court, adult court, domestic court, schools and more. Apply for free or reduced fee services.

Direct representation to survivors of sexual assault, domestic violence, and stalking. Advice includes legal needs such as housing, safety, family, and other issues intertwined with instances of violence.

Reduced fee referral program available to those who qualify. (Maximum retainer of \$500 & \$75 per hour rate. Filing fees & other out-of-pocket costs to be paid by the client.)

Call to ask if there is an attorney in your area that offers limited scope representation, otherwise the service will refer you to an attorney who may be able to assist you with your problem

\* Low income qualification may be required.
