Annual PhD Student Evaluation Process

Each year marketing faculty provide feedback to PhD students on their goal progress. The process has two parts. First students submit a self-evaluation form that is then distributed to all marketing/management department faculty who for the most recent academic year have worked with them in class, had them assigned as a TA/GA, or served as an advisor. The faculty evaluate them in four areas including:

- 1: Acquire Advanced Knowledge Relevant to Areas of Specialization
- 2: Develop Advanced Research Skills for Areas of Specialization
- 3: Be Able to Assume Teaching Responsibilities at High-Quality Colleges and Universities
- 4: Successfully Graduate and Place at High-Quality Colleges and Universities

For each of these areas, PhD students will be rated based on the following scale: 4 excellent, 3 good, 2 fair, 1 poor, NA not applicable. The PhD Program Director (in consultation with the Department Head) compiles the feedback and provides each student with a final evaluation by June 30th.
