



**ANNUAL TB UPDATE FORM**

Per University of Wyoming School of Nursing policy, you will not be tested for TB as a result of your having reported a documented history of a past positive TB test. (This is based on the recommendations of the Tuberculosis Policy Statement, Wyoming Epidemiologic Bulletin, Supplemental Issue, August, 1989.) However, you are required to provide initial documentation of a chest x-ray and results to the School of Nursing for enclosure in your student file. Annually thereafter, (while in the School of Nursing program) you may opt to either:

- 1) provide documentation of annual chest x-ray results

**OR**

- 2) complete this form annually with your healthcare provider and submit it to the School of Nursing for enclosure in your student file.

You are responsible for reporting any of the following group of symptoms immediately to your Clinical (Faculty) Advisor.

The symptoms of TB are as follows:

- Listlessness
- Vague chest pain
- Weight loss
- Night sweats
- Fever
- Loss of appetite
- For women – irregular menses

I have read the above information and have been given an opportunity to ask questions. I agree to report to my Clinical (Faculty) Advisor immediately any of the above symptoms.
