




Figure 1. Headcount of Wyoming Community College Transfers Academic Years 2018-19 to 2022-23







Figure 6a. Transfers to UW with Eligible* Associate's Degrees Fall 2018 - Fall 2022







New Transfer Students:	Undergraduate students who previously attended a higher education institution, have been officially admitted to the University of Wyoming (UW), and are attending UW as a degree-seeking student for the first time. 


Figure 11a. [Proposed] Community College Transfer Credits Equivalency




Figure 11b. [Proposed] Community College Transfer Credits Equivalency
