The MAGP graduate assistantship includes a tuition-and-fee waiver **and** a stipend for performing services (working) in the department in which the student is pursuing a degree or in an MA approved placement for the academic year only. Continuing students who wish to apply for continuing support the following year must complete a new application. If academic progress and work performance as a graduate assistant are unsatisfactory, Multicultural Affairs, upon consultation with the department, will rescind or modify the award.

A complete MAGP application includes:

- A completed MAGP application form**
- A copy of your GRE – LSAT – GMAT or other Scores used to gain admissions to UW**
- A letter of support from your department head addressing the following:**
 - *You have met college/departmental requirements*
 - *You have been accepted to do graduate work in the department*
 - *You have applied for a departmental GA and what the departmental decision was on the award.*
 - *You have the department’s recommendation to apply for this award.*
- A high quality, well thought-out personal statement written specifically for the MAGP assistantship which includes the following information:**
 - *Brief history or your ethnic minority background*
 - *Current higher education status and achievements*
 - *Extra-curricular and community-related activities (especially past & current minority involvement)*
 - *Academic & career goals*
 - *Financial support and need to meet your goals*
 - *Unusual circumstances or any other information relevant to your application*
 - *Your potential to contribute back the minority community upon graduation*
- A copy of your unofficial transcripts for all college credits or degrees earned**

Applications must be complete and must be received by July 1st.
