For fiscal year 2009-2010 the University of Wyoming received \$101 million in external awards, the 24th consecutive year that a new record in external funding has been set. This amazing string of record years is due to the hard work of UW faculty and staff. This year's total contains about \$13 million of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding and while this amount is substantial (and competitively awarded for the most part) it does not account for the total increase recorded for the fiscal year. In addition to the ARRA funds there was an increase of approximately \$7 million in non-ARRA awards to UW faculty and staff. This \$7 million represents about 6% growth over inflation.

Two reasons underlie the reported federal funding increase. First, and most importantly, UW faculty and staff are increasingly competitive for federal awards. And secondly, we are seeing the impact of ARRA funding to the institution.

These awards provide support to all the University's key missions of research, teaching and service. And while the Office of Research and Economic Development is charged with accounting for all external awards we also celebrate what these funds do to support students, create new knowledge and new applications of existing knowledge, enhance research infrastructure and support the University's service mission to the state of Wyoming.

This year's report is different in that it reports the standard external sponsored program funding using historic methodologies for determining the \$101 million. This allows us to compare prior years' data. In addition we report \$83 million in institutional funding which are the Abandoned Mine Lands funds supporting the High Plains Gasification – Advanced Technology Center program, the School for Energy Resources, Clean Coal Technology and \$27 million in ARRA funding for major maintenance. Finally in a third category we show the Direct Student Loans which UW now administers as a result of federal legislation shifting students loans from private lenders to the student's academic institution; there is about \$22 million in these loan funds.

The Research Office congratulates all who have received awards over the past year. Through your hard work, UW's reputation grows and our constituents' benefit.








