



CALL FOR PROPOSALS

Nuclear Energy Research Center

The Nuclear Energy Research Center (NERC) at the UW School of Energy Resources (SER) is focused on interdisciplinary nuclear-energy capacity building across the UW community by connecting UW faculty and staff that are already active in research fields critical to the success of nuclear energy, and developing collaborative relationships both external and internal to UW.

COMPETITIVE NUCLEAR ENERGY SUMMER GA/DOCTORAL AUGMENTATION GRANT:

Funding through NERC available for faculty to apply for summer GA positions (Doctoral or Masters) or doctoral augmentation awards to support nuclear energy research or thesis preparation.



PURPOSE: To support summer graduate assistant positions focused on nuclear energy research or thesis preparation.



REQUIREMENTS: Please submit a two-page proposal describing the budget request, description of the research project, and a CV for the graduate student.



AMOUNT: Funding for 1 full time summer graduate assistant (masters, PhD, MBA, J.D. degree level) or hourly non-benefited research assistant plus up to \$1,000 for student supplies or travel.



CRITERIA: Grantees selected based on relevance to nuclear energy research and NERC mission.

DEADLINE:

For maximum consideration, faculty should submit proposals prior to March 31, 2022

Proposals submitted after the deadline will be considered based on remaining available funds on a rolling basis.

Multiple student funding positions available.
