
Applying to Master of Science Programs in the SMTC: Concentration in Natural Science Education (NED) (Spring 2022)



Application Deadline: February 1, 2022

Application Steps (Year 2 at University of Wyoming):

- Go to Admissions.
- Enter your UW username and password from Year One or "forgot password" to reset.
- For the Program of Study choose Natural Science MS College of Education (Natural Science Educ.) Start Year Two at UW.
 - Check Environment Natural Resources for a concurrent major/minor if desired.
- To complete the application follow the directions on the application page. Please use an email address other than your Teton Science Schools email.
- You will need:
 - A current resume
 - GRE scores (minimum 292 combined verbal and quantitative; 3.5 analytical writing if taken) <u>OR</u> an Alternative Portfolio (information sent by Admissions)
 - Three letters of recommendation:
 - One letter from a TSS Graduate Program faculty member
 - One letter from another TSS employee who is familiar with your work in Year 1 and your potential to be a successful graduate student at UW
 - One letter from the first year application
 - To use a previous recommendation letter from Year 1, enter <u>gradprogram@tetonscience.org</u> in the section about recommenders. Then email the same account and let them know which reference you would like to use; the grad program administrators will upload it.
 - A completed writing sample (questions sent by Admissions)
 - All applicants must complete the three writing sample questions
 - For those choosing the alternative portfolio option, the writing sample is reviewed as Part 1 and two additional questions will be sent to serve as Part 2
 - All information is filled in on the Admissions website and documents such as the current resume and writing sample are loaded in "Documents Upload." Follow the instructions carefully.
 - 3 Special Notes:
 - 1. The \$50 application fee to UW is only required once and should have been paid when you applied for Year 1 at TSS.
 - 2. ALL of your official transcripts from all postsecondary institutions attended should have been submitted when you applied for Year 1. Completion of a Bachelor's degree must be indicated on a transcript.
 - 3. UW requires a minimum GPA of 3.0 across all institutions attended and courses completed. Students with less than a 3.0 GPA are encouraged to apply and can be admitted on a provisional basis for the first semester at UW. SMTC will make a case for any students who are recommended for admissions by the SMTC Admissions Committee.
