This scholarship is open to social work students who are BSW admitted majors and MSW students. Recipients of this scholarship will be awarded half in the fall semester and half in the spring semester. Students must meet university criteria for nontraditional status, defined as follows:

- 25 years of age or older
- Returning to college after absence, or
- Single parent

Scholarship Requirements:

- Admitted major in the University of Wyoming's BSW program, or
- Admitted social work graduate student (MSW) at the University of Wyoming
- Demonstrated academic success as described in current BSW & MSW Handbooks
- Complete the one-page application, and
- Submit an explanation of how this scholarship will contribute to your ability to be a successful student in the social work program (statement of financial need).
- Submit materials on or before due date as advertised on the Social Work website
