A maximum of 7 credits can be accepted for both the Elementary Education major and the ECE minor.

Elementary Education majors who complete the 22 hours of courses for the minor and a 6-credit hour Supervised Internship in Early Childhood Education are eligible for the PTSB Early Childhood Birth- age 8 Endorsement.

FCSC majors who complete the 22 hours of courses for the minor and a 6-credit hour Child Development Internship are eligible for the PTSB Preschool 3-5 Endorsement.
