PHASE III PLACEMENT GUIDELINES

Your Residency placement will provide you with the best possible academic experiences as you pursue a teaching career. Our goal is to provide you with a quality classroom experience, in which you will have the opportunity to learn from a master teacher, to try out your own teaching style, and to have professional supervision throughout this process. Your placement will be determined by the UW faculty and school district personnel and the availability of quality mentor teachers in the Partner School Districts. The Office of Teacher Education provides logistical support for the placement process but has no part in the determination of your Residency placement.

The following are guidelines for Phase III placement:

1. Phase III placements will be concentrated in the following Partner School districts: **Albany #1 (Laramie); Campbell County #1 (Gillette/Wright); Laramie #1 (Cheyenne) and Natrona #1 (Casper)**. Every effort will be made to concentrate Phase III placements in these Partner School sites, with the exception of Agricultural Education where placements will be concentrated in a region of the state. Under extraordinary circumstances, placements outside these school districts will be considered at the discretion of the Department Head and the Associate Dean of Undergraduate Programs.
2. All field experiences associated with Phase IIIa/b will occur in your assigned Residency placement district. Methods field requirements will vary dependent upon major content area. You will complete EDSE 427X (Methods) in the fall semester and EDSE 4500 (Residency) in the spring semester with the same mentor teacher in the same school district.
3. You will not be placed in the same building you attended as a student; in a building where your children are enrolled; in a building where your spouse or other relative is employed; in a building where a relative is attending school; with a cooperating teacher who is a relative. Phase III students will not be placed in a parochial school (United States Court of Appeals, Eighth Circuit 1986, Stark and Sentz, Appellees v. St. Cloud State University Appellant).
4. The Placement Preference Statement is your opportunity to present a detailed rationale for a Phase III placement in a specific Wyoming Partner School district. The statement will be reviewed by College of Education faculty and administration. Submission of a statement ***does not guarantee*** placement in your preferred school district. Financial hardship will not be considered as an extraordinary circumstance in *any* placement decision.

Final placements are determined by the school district in collaboration with the UW Secondary Education Department.

I understand that it is my responsibility to submit the Phase IIIa/b complete application by the published deadline date. Incomplete applications will not be processed. Late applications will require special permission to be accepted. A late application may seriously interfere with my progress into the residency semester.

I understand that I must submit the Misdemeanor/Felony Addendum indicating whether I have been convicted of a misdemeanor(s) and/or felony/felonies. An affirmative response requires a separate signed and dated statement.

If I am convicted of a felony or misdemeanor other than minor traffic offenses AFTER signing this form, I will immediately report the offense to the College of Education, Office of Teacher Education, McWhinnie Hall, room 100.

I understand that all field placements are made by participating partnership school districts. I will not pursue my own placement or change in my placement (i.e. grade level, mentor teacher, school, etc.) once finalized. I will neither request nor encourage a third party to intercede on my behalf to secure a field placement. I understand that if I do, my field placement will be jeopardized.

I understand that my Phase III placement will not be made in the same building I attended as a student; in a building where my children are enrolled; in a building where my spouse or other relative is employed; in a building where a relative is attending school; with a cooperating teacher who is a relative. Phase III students will not be placed in a parochial school (United States Court of Appeals, Eighth Circuit, 1986, Stark and Sentz, Appellees v. St. Cloud State University, Appellant.)

I understand that I must have met **all** prerequisites (according to my major) for Phase III prior to beginning the Phase IIIa semester.

I understand the prerequisite grade point average requirements for entry into Phase IIIa/b and that I must meet and maintain a **minimum UW Total Institution grade point average of 2.75** for admission to Phase IIIa/b as well as **minimum major content grade point average of 2.50** for admission to Phase IIIb of the Wyoming Teacher Education Program.

I understand that if I enroll in courses at a college or a university other than UW, I will have the official transcript(s) sent to the UW Office of Admissions **immediately** after grades for the course(s) have been posted. I WILL ALSO PROVIDE THE OFFICE OF TEACHER EDUCATION WITH A PHOTOCOPY OF THE OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT(S) FOR MY PHASE III FILE. I WILL NOT FAX ANY TRANSCRIPTS.

I understand that I am responsible for securing living accommodations in the community in which I am placed for Phase III.

I certify that I am capable of, and will be available for, any allied activities that may be assigned in the course of my Phase III experience.

I understand that the contact information available from the UW Office of the Registrar will be used by the Office of Teacher Education for all purposes of contacting me.

I understand that it is my responsibility to submit a signed and dated statement to the Office of Teacher Education if I decide to withdraw from Phase IIIa/b for any reason.

I understand that the Phase IIIa/b application and all supporting documents become the property of the University of Wyoming College of Education and will be shared with the appropriate personnel in the school district(s) providing WTEP placements. This and other relevant information from my student records may be released to designated UW personnel and appropriate school district personnel when deemed necessary and appropriate by the Associate Dean of Undergraduate Programs.

I understand that a low GPA and/or misdemeanor/felony conviction(s) may delay or prevent my placement.

I understand that the department will make reasonable effort to find a Residency placement, but that final placement decisions are made by the individual school districts.

I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure my Wyoming Substitute Teaching Permit is valid, and to renew it prior to expiration, should it expire before the completion of my Residency (student teaching) semester.

I understand that if my application is denied, and I subsequently meet all of the Phase III eligibility requirements prior to the beginning of the fall methods semester, it is my responsibility to submit a College of Education petition form to the Office of Teacher Education requesting the re-activation/rescreening of my application and reconsideration for a possible Residency (student teaching) placement. I understand that there is no guarantee that my petition will be approved and that I can enter Phase IIIa (Methods) and Phase IIIb (Residency) for the current application year.

I understand that submission of the Placement Preference Statement ***does not guarantee*** placement in my preferred school district and that financial hardship will not be considered as an extraordinary circumstance in *any* placement decision.

I will apply online through the UW Admissions Office (<http://www.uwyo.edu/admissions/graduate/index.html>) for the Graduate Certificate in Teaching Secondary Content (**CERT TSC**) for summer semester 2016 within 48 hours of receiving my notification of provisional acceptance to the Post-Baccalaureate teacher certification program.
