Professor Godby (Ph.D., McMaster University, Hamilton, Ontario, 1997) was appointed to the Department of Economics in 1997. His teaching interests include macroeconomics, industrial organization, econometrics and resource and environmental economics and policy. Professor Godby's research covers a number of areas. In the past, he has studied the design of market-based environmental regulatory mechanisms, and in particular the design of emission trading markets. In an unrelated research project, he is also considering the determinants of campaign finance expenditures in federal elections, while in another research study funded by the State of Wyoming, he is involved in defining a regional funding mechanism to be used in the state's school finance models. Dr. Godby was tenured in 2003 and has served as Department Head in the Department of Economics and most recently served as the Associate Dean in the Haub School for Environment and Natural Resources.
