UARC Meeting Minutes for 6 October 2009

President Doris KD7RQX called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm local time at the Village Inn restaurant on East Grand Avenue. In attendance were Bill AF7E, Wayne NQ7Q, John KE7MXO, John KD7NAE, Doris KD7RQX, Doug KD7W, Jim KD7KMU, Jerry N7JT, David KC6WZP, Suzanne AA7AY, Paul W7MO, Lloyd WA7SVH, Tom KE7BKV, and Gery KE7HTD.

Treasurer's report – none this month.

There was discussion of RSO requirements and UARC club status as an RSO.

Bill AF7E moved that UARC seek standing with the University as a Special Services Organization rather than as a RSO in order to remain a resource for students and the University as well as the community at large. Members present felt it is important to have senior club members in leadership positions even though they are not students in order to maintain long term continuity as a non-profit 501(c)3 Corporation, ensure the ongoing maintenance of the club's important repeater and radio resources, maintain the N7UW station license and provide the experienced leadership needed for the volunteer, community service and emergency services that the club is called on to perform. Many of these activities occur in the summer months when student members may not be available. The motion was unanimously carried.

The Forest Service site inventory questionnaire for this year has been received for the .820 repeater site on Beacon Hill.

Recommendations of the nominating committee for UARC officers were presented by Bill AF7E and Wayne NQ7Q. Their recommendations were to retain Doris KD7RQX as President, John KE7MXO as Vice President, John KD7NAE as Secretary and Doug KD7W as Faculty Advisor. Jake K7SIG was the committee's recommended nominee for the post of Treasurer.

All the committees recommended officers were nominated and elected unanimously by vote of UARC members present except for the Vice President. New student member Tom KE7BKV was nominated for Vice President and unanimously elected to the post.

John KD7NAE will continue to act as editor of the Code of the West news letter.
