Eligibility: Open to any Natrona County 4-H/FFA member or 4-H Leader who has previously received this scholarship and is:

- Currently enrolled as a full-time college student (12 credit hours) or full time status (technical school) and
- Has a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5

Terms of Scholarship:

- One-half of the scholarship must be used the fall semester after it is awarded at any Junior College, University or Technical School.
- The second half of the scholarship will be awarded after the recipient re-enrolls for the second semester and shows proof that he or she has maintained a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA for the previous semester.

The requirements for your application are as follows:

- Complete the scholarship application form with appropriate signatures.
- There will be NO phone or live interview.
- Answer the questions listed below.
- Attach an OFFICIAL/CERTIFIED TRANSCRIPT.
- A current photo must be included.
