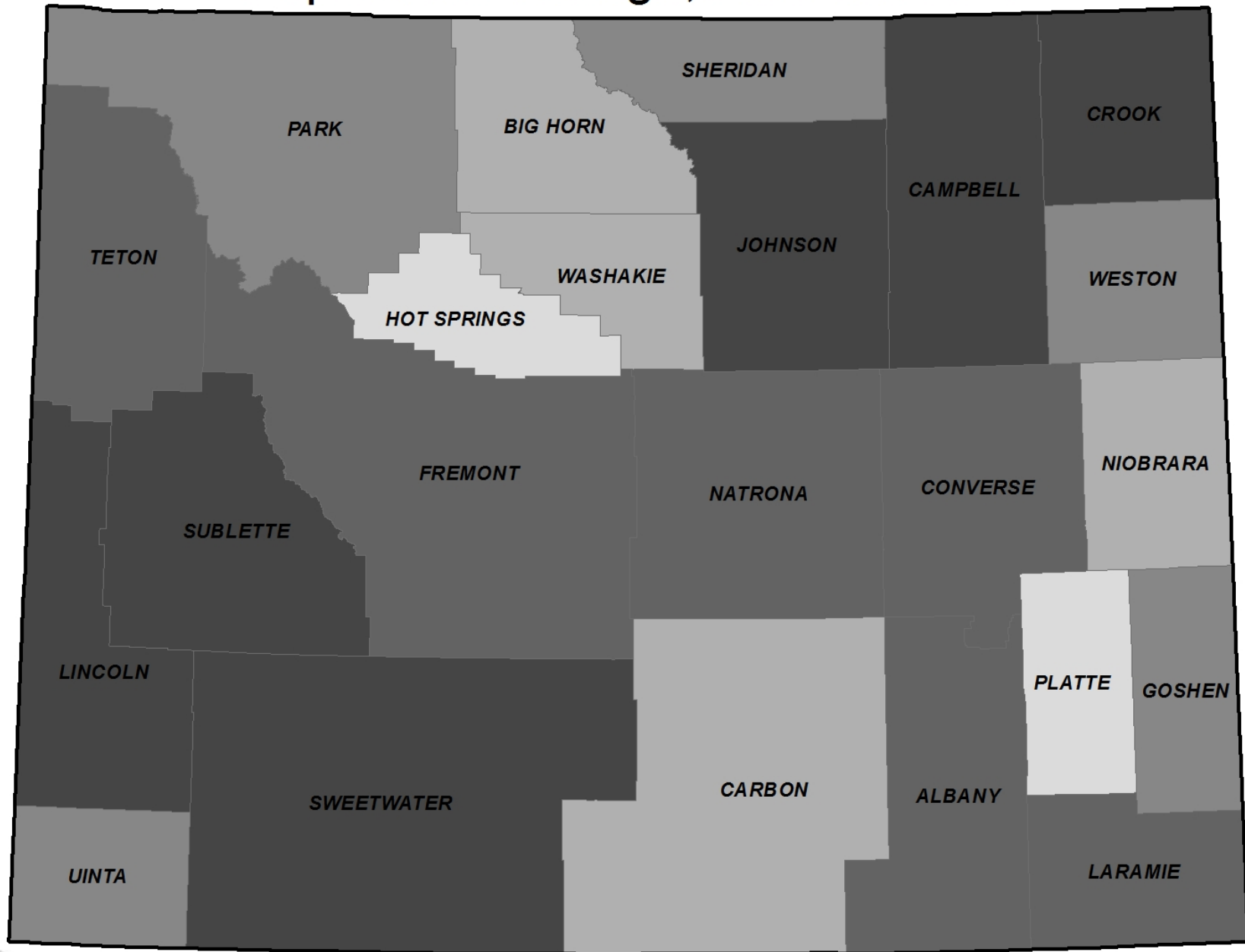


Population Change, 2000 to 2010
