Professional Development Training Description and Objectives:	A Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP) is a specific plan of action that designs effective positive interventions to teach the student more acceptable behavior(s) to replace the inappropriate behavior. The purpose is to teach the student more appropriate behaviors that meet the same function, or purpose, as the inappropriate behaviors previously exhibited. The BIP includes a combination of multiple interventions based on the student and environmental needs and linked to each element of the hypothesis statement (e.g., antecedents, behavior, function). 1.
