Professional Development Training Description and Objectives:	Social skills are those communication, problem-solving, decision making, self-management, and peer relations abilities that allow one to initiate, build, and maintain positive social relationships with others. Deficits or excesses in social behavior interfere with friendship, adult-child relationships, learning, teaching, and the classroom's orchestration and climate. Social skills training is a general term for instruction conducted in (behavioral) areas that promotes more productive/positive interaction with others. There are some specific considerations that should be made when selecting a social skills curriculum or teaching strategies. Participants will be: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Familiar with social skills deficits. 2. Familiar with successful strategies for teaching social skills. 3. Familiar with considerations necessary when selecting social skills curriculum.
