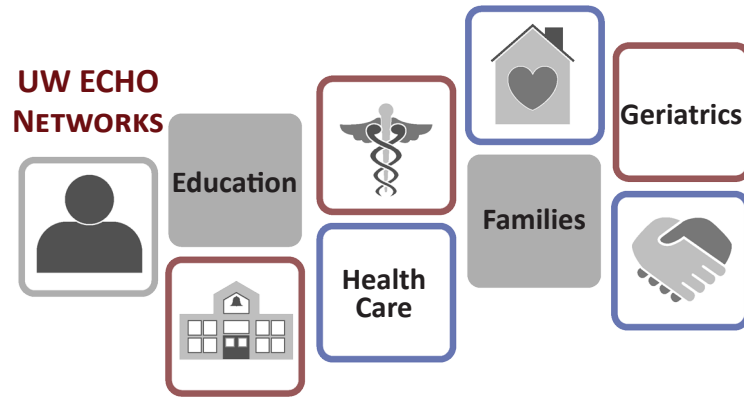

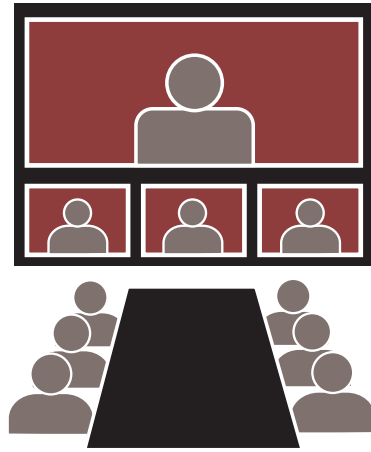


## ABOUT THE ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY NETWORK

### WHAT IS UW ECHO?

UW ECHO offers virtual professional development to support community conversations around best practice in education, health, and disability services.

The **Assistive Technology** network provides training and the sharing of best practices for educators and service providers to consider, implement, and evaluate the use of assistive technology to improve outcomes for students.



### WHO SHOULD ATTEND:

Network participants include assistive technology professionals, specialists and teams, school administrators, general and special education teachers, paraeducators, case managers, school counselors, school psychologists, state agency staff, and special education service providers, including OTs, PTs, SLPs, etc.
