Pilot Project Updates/Presentations

- Local Farm & Food Solutions: Community-Led Research Providing Free CSA's Megan Taylor, Edible Prairie to Enable SNAP and WIC Users to Improve Their Health and Food Security in Project Campbell County, WY
 - Produce to feed a family of 4 (SNAP and WIC) (three seasons)
 - Connect consumer with local farmers
 - Non-profit on both ends
 - Looked at impact of baskets on food insecurity
 - Improved food security and increase in vegetable intake
 - Sample size = 12 eligible families
 - Community involvement started in 2019, grant in 2020
 - Participants provided input on to what they as families needed
 - Knife cutting sets
 - They liked participating and providing feedback since their input drives future work
 - Looking to make the baskets free instead of original \$10 charge
 - Created cost tiers
 - Half of baskets are offered free this year
- Wyoming's Community-Based Participatory Research Project: Does Assistive Michelle Blakely Technology Improve Healthcare Interactions between Community Pharmacists and Deaf/Hard of Hearing Patients?
 - Objective identify barriers for using assistive technology
 - Reached out to local Deaf and Hard of Hearing individuals to create open ended questions
 - Mixed methods, cross sectional study
 - Questions sent out to Wyoming pharmacies
