The Wyoming Institute for Disabilities has dedicated our annual award to the founder if this center, Dr. Keith A. Miller. Dr. Miller worked for many years at the University of Wyoming in Social Work before he began laying the groundwork for a University Center for Excellence in Developmental

Disabilities (UCEDD) in 1986. After several years of planning, the Wyoming Institute for Disabilities was officially launched in November of 1994, and Dr. Miller served as the director until his retirement in 2007.

Keith A. Miller built his career upon the philosophy that everyone should help communities become more welcoming to and supportive of people with disabilities. It is Dr. Miller's spirit of dedication and desire for excellence in being "a force fighting for people with disabilities" that has inspired the Keith A. Miller Award.

- ► Notable accomplishments impacting policy or systems at local, state or national levels;
- ► Extraordinary family members and/or caregivers;
- Any other commitment to improving experiences or opportunities for the disability community.

Nominations must include the Nomination form as well as a letter of support containing the following information:

- ► How long and in what capacity you have known the nominee:
- ▶ An explanation of why the nominee deserves the award;
- ► Overall impact of the nominee's service or work in developmental disabilities.
