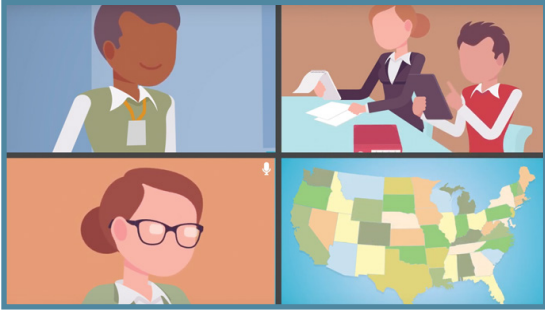


JOIN US TO LEARN ABOUT PROJECT SCOPE (SUPPORTING CHILDREN OF THE OPIOID EPIDEMIC)



Join us on September 12, 2022, to learn about Project SCOPE (Supporting Children of the OPIoid Epidemic).

Project SCOPE is a national training initiative building nationwide provider capacity and confidence in applying evidence-based practices in screening, monitoring, and interdisciplinary support for children and families diagnosed with Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (NAS), Neonatal Opioid Withdrawal Syndrome (NOWS), or who are suspected of being impacted by opioid use, trauma, or related exposure.

This informational session will provide an overview of the project, its success, and the impacts of the three-year implementation across 14 states. Additionally, project members from each state will be on the call to answer questions about the impact in their states and opportunities for ongoing collaboration and support.
