<b>Interest</b> Degree to which applicant expresses interest and describes current initiatives to support the implementation of Project SCOPE.	3
<b>Readiness</b> Degree to which applicant is ready or can be ready to implement project following required training and technical assistance.	3
<b>Sustainability</b> Degree to which applicant is able to sustain the project during and beyond the grant period.	3
<b>Organizational Capacity</b> Degree to which applicant has the supportive infrastructure for applicant to successfully launch and complete project.	3
<b>Interagency Partnerships</b> Degree to which applicant has existing or will develop new partnerships for the successful launch and completion of project.	3
<b>Leveraged Funding</b> Degree to which applicant may be able to leverage existing or new funding for the sustainability of the project within the state.	3
<b>Commitment to required Project SCOPE components (training, TA, evaluation)</b> Degree to which the applicant is committed and has commitment by interagency partners to attend the required trainings.	3
