Assistive technology can be a device, tool, or adaptation that allows a person to live, work, and play independently and participate in every day activities.

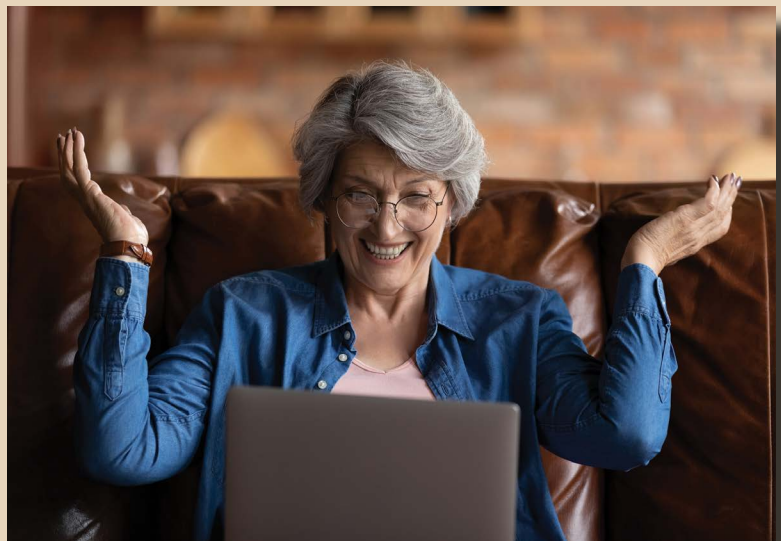
What is the role of an Assistive Technology Council member?
