Dashboards Defined

A dashboard is a visual interface that provides at-a-glance views into key measures relevant to a particular objective or business process.

- Key Attributes:
 - Graphical to focus attention on key trends
 - Comparisons and exceptions
 - Display only relevant data
- Collecting user requirements is KEY


UW Dashboard Key Characteristics

- 1. Reflect UP3, with a focus on current strategic priorities
- 2. Tell the stories contained in the Fact Sheet (summary of UW key performance indicators)
- 3. Work with existing UW reports, customize by drilling deeper into the data
- 4. Include data on inputs, output and outcomes
- 5. Focus on six key functional areas:
 - Students, Faculty & Staff, Tuition & Fees, Research Funding & Private
 Giving, Budget & Finance, Statewide Activities
- 6. Unique, flexible design with iPad functionality










