

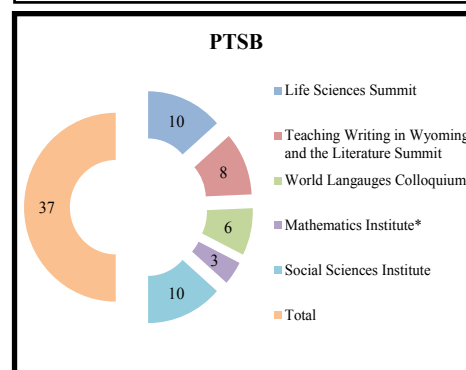
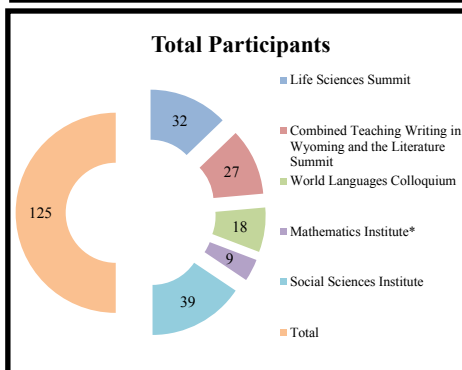
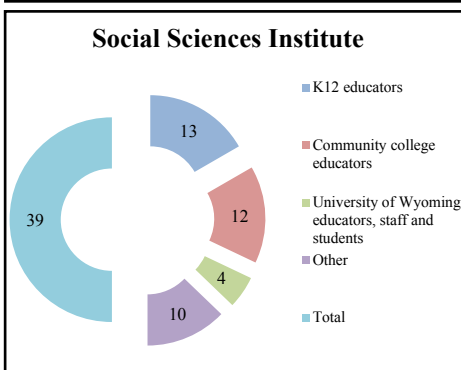
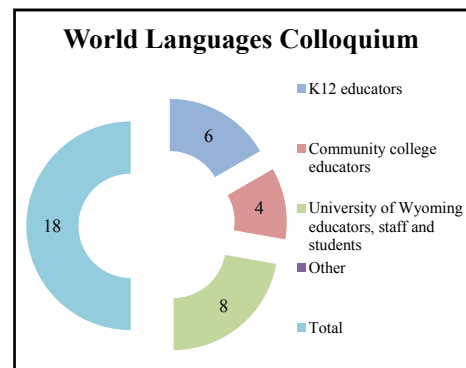
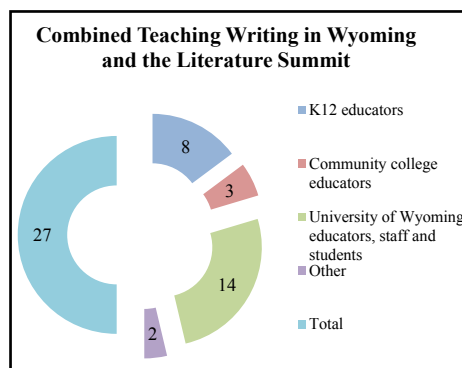
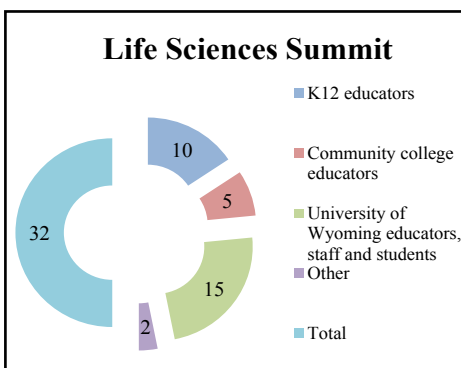
Lost in Transition Initiative

2015-2016 Annual Report

Since 2006, the Partnership's Lost in Transition Initiative has been providing professional development forums to discuss how to best help students successfully transition from high school to higher education. These discussions center around the existing academic gap between high school and higher education and seek to bring better understanding of educational practices at all levels. Below is a summary of the Lost in Transition events for the 2015-2016 school year.
