educators received 0.5 Wyoming Professional Teaching Standards Board (PTSB) credit from Partnership coordinated and cosponsored events.

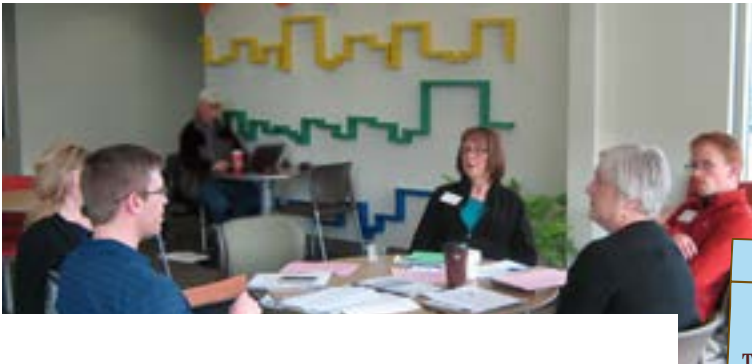


NNER
