June 17, 2019 -- Upon the recommendation of the HCM implementation team, the WyoCloud Executive Steering Committee supports the decision to go live with time entry on June 16 for hourly, non-benefited employees, and time and absence entry for salaried, benefited employees on July 1.

Many people from Payroll, HR, Information Technology, Finance and Huron Consulting have spent countless hours over the past year and half in developing business processes, configuring the system, converting data, integrating information with other systems, and testing this most complex part of the system.
